

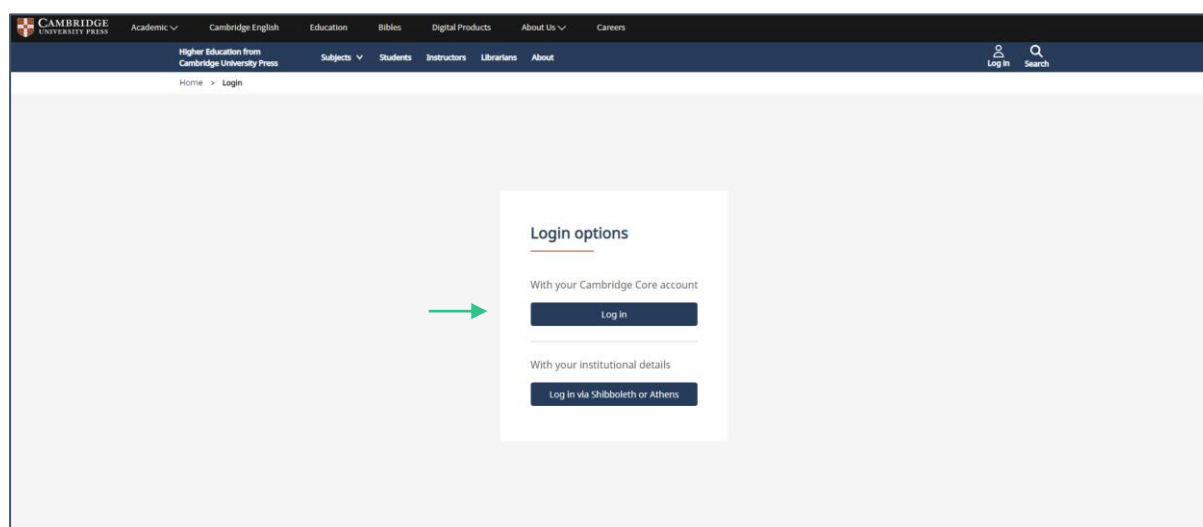


The new Higher Education (HE) beta site provides the convenience of online institutional access to textbooks using the same technology as Cambridge Core. The beta version of the HE website launched in late June offers basic functionality and a limited selection of textbooks to show you the site's new features. Further developments and more titles will be made live in August.

This user guide provides students, instructors and librarians with step-by-step information on using the site. Please note that since the site is still in its beta launch phase, a number of features are not yet publicly available.
